ROYAL ARCH STRATEGY FOR WILTSHIRE

OUR VISION

To view the Royal Arch in Wiltshire as the most appealing Order in which to belong, through Convocations that are interesting, memorable, and enjoyable for all Companions.

That every Master Mason is aware from an early stage of the affinity that exists between the Royal Arch and the Craft as described in the Preliminary Declaration. Encouraging every Master Mason to complete their journey in Pure Antient Masonry.

OUR GOALS

To heighten the awareness of those Brethren yet to complete their journey from Initiation to Exaltation and encourage them to become Companions of the Royal Arch in Wiltshire.

To encourage and support the Chapters to ensure best practice is adopted and maintained to enhance the welcome and experience of the Exaltee while maintaining the interests of the members.

To improve the Companions knowledge of the Order that they may better be enabled to understand the meaning of our ceremonies. Two examples - Your Chapter in Camera and commentary on the Royal Arch ceremony.

To provide guidance, support and encouragement to all Chapters enabling them to thrive and maintain growth.

To encourage unattached Royal Arch masons to reconnect with the Order to once again enjoy the Companionship established within our Chapters.

To assist Chapters to develop their own strategies to develop growth in line with that of the Province.

OUR OBJECTIVES

To increase our conversion rate of Craft to Royal Arch Masons from the current 32% to 40% by 2030.

To increase the combined recruitment of Candidates and Joining members by 5% every year.

To decrease resignations by 5% per annum.

To retrieve 3% of unattached Companions per annum.

THE WAY FORWARD

To ensure every Master Mason receives a joint letter from the Provincial Grand Master and Grand Superintendent congratulating him on his raising and recommending the Royal Arch as his next step in completing his journey in Pure Antient Masonry.

To invite Master Masons and Past Masters to an introductory presentation of the Royal Arch in Wiltshire.

To appoint, maintain and provide support a Royal Arch representative in every lodge.

To provide the Royal Arch representatives with relevant information as appropriate to assist in the delivery in promoting of the Royal Arch.

Continue to promote and encourage the sharing of the ritual amongst as many Companions as possible.

To encourage Companions to support other than their own Chapters, to increase visiting through our initiative - the Travelling Quaich.

To offer Craft Lodges lectures/presentations appertaining to the Royal Arch and continue to deliver Talking Heads when requested.

To promote educational lectures/papers via Solomon.

The Provincial Executive and active Provincial Officers to provide assistance, demonstrations and undertake Exaltation ceremonies when invited or called upon.

To provide quarterly Royal Arch newsletters to all Companions via the Scribe E's.

To provide effective and consistent communications with all Chapters.


